MEMBERS' NOTICEBOARD

IVY (BABICH) CIBILICH





Ivy's connection with our Society began when the Club was in Hobson St in the mid-1940's. At that time it was called the Yugoslav Marshal Tito Society, which later changed to the Yugoslav Benevolent Society.

Ivy was always proud that she danced in Kolo in the Auckland Town Hall to celebrate the defeat of the Nazis and where the Kolo included a formation of the name Tito. Photos of Ivy in the Kolo in 1947 and 1948 are on display in our collection of Folklore photos.

Ivy married Tom Cibilich, who also performed in the kolo. They then had the Gulf Fish shop in Three Lamps, Ponsonby. Ivy worked with her husband until they both retired. Tom and Ivy built a substantial brick home in Fife St, Westmere in which they enjoyed many years of married life. Ivy later sold her Fife St property and moved to Epsom.

Ivy became involved in the Yugoslav Benevolent Society's affairs, later when it moved to Karangahape Rd in 1965. She served on its committee and was later elected vice-president in 1981, the year when the Yugoslav Club and the Yugoslav Benevolent Society merged.

She became the first female president of the Yugoslav Society, where she held that position from 1986 to 1989.

Ivy was always at the fore, when it came to the Society's affairs, be it concerts, Society celebrations, ladies lunches, fashion shows, folklore, funerals - Ivy was there. She had an excellent voice as a speaker and did not rely on any notes.

On 16 October 2010, at a function to commemorate the 80th anniversary since the founding of the Society, Ivy as the Society's first female President cut a cake together with George Mihaljevich, a former president of the Yugoslav Society and Dalmatian Cultural Society and Tony (TK) Barbarich, the Society's oldest life member.

Sadly as her health deteriorated, Ivy could not participate in the activities which were an important part of her life.
