**Jessie Seaman QSM**

Recently the Team Tarara walkers were in National Park and I met one of our long-time country members in Raetihi. Jessie Seaman (nee Curach) has lived in Raetihi for over 75yrs, and is a recognised icon of the community. She worked as a radiographer at Waimarino Hospital and has always been a keen outdoors person and avid trumper. Born in Korčula in 1922, Jessie came to NZ as a 14 year old refugee. After training as a nurse she ended up in Raetihi where she at first thought "it was the last place God must have made". Raetihi and it's townsfolk took care of the young nurse, and she has been taking care of most everybody ever since. In 2008 as a mere 86 year old, Jessie was instructed to accept the Queen's Service Medal for community services, having formally declined the honour by simply saying "I don't like all that stuff". Jessie has been (and still is) a keen supporter of the Dalmatian Cultural Society, her parish of St Joseph and the Ruapehu Rugby Club. If you are ever in Raetihi, and wanting historical information about the history of former Yugoslavia, anything about NZ rugby, or any mountain track in National Park, just ask anyone in Raetihi for Jessie's address, no second name will be required!

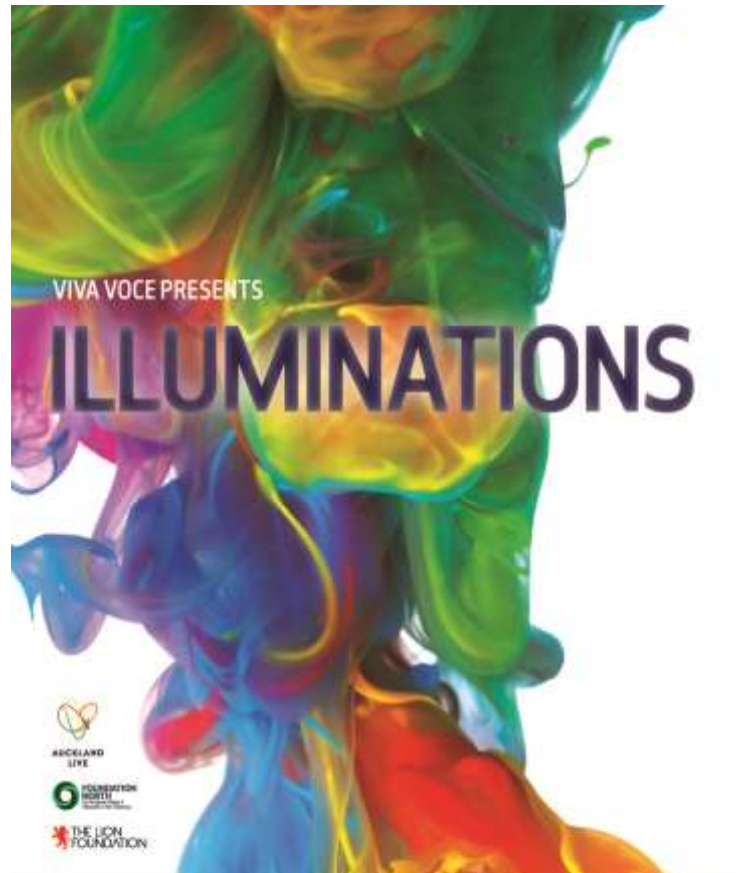

## TRIP HOME 2018

The Tarara Folklore Ensemble (17 dancers) and 25 supporters are heading off on 7 July on an historic trip for our Society. It is the first "trip home" since 1989! Details are given here of the dates we will be in each of our stopovers, the accommodation we have booked, and when the performances will take place. We hope that many of you are able to join with us on at least one of the days we are there.

We leave Auckland on Saturday 7 July on Qatar Airlines, bound for Doha then Beograd; and leave Zagreb on 30 July, bound for Doha then Auckland, arriving at 4am on Wednesday 1 August. (Some travellers are staying on longer).

### Sunday 8 July – Thursday 12 July (5 nights)

Our first bus will pick us up at Beograd airport and we will be staying in Kragujevac, in the Šumadija region of Serbia. This is the home town of our tutor Nenad. Activities will include a city walk, district tour, and a day trip to Beograd. The area has monasteries, vineyards, Jagodina Aqua Park, and we may be there for the Vinjačka Banja Fair Day. We have a concert booked for Thursday 12 July and one or two other performances are still being finalised. ### Friday 13 July – Monday 16 July (4 nights)

On Friday we will cross into Croatia and travel all the way to Istria, where we will stay in Pula. On Saturday we will be checking out the Rovinj area on our new bus, with a performance and meal at Bale. On Sunday we will sightseeing around Pula, and have a performance and meal at Vodnjan. On Monday we will explore the central Istria area around Motovun, with a performance and meal at Pazin. On Friday we will drive from Zagreb to the Plitvice Jezera and have a good look around this beautiful spot, and then head on to Novi Vinodolski. The local community is organising an event for us (including performance) on Saturday. They are also organising our accommodation, and our hotel is not yet confirmed.



### Sunday 22 July – Tuesday 24 July (3 nights)

On Sunday we will drive from Novi Vinodolski to Split and spend most of the day sightseeing in this beautiful city, then drive on to Makarska after having dinner in Kaštela. We will have a chance to spend some time at the beach in Makarska and have a performance booked for Monday. In Makarska we will be staying in private apartments.



### Wednesday 25 July – Sunday 29 July (5 nights)

After spending Wednesday in Makarska we will drive to our hotel in Vrgorac. On Thursday we have a day trip to Mostar, where we may have a performance (to be confirmed). On Friday our group (along with others) will perform in the Espod Matokit Festival in Vrgorac, and on Saturday we will have an end of tour celebration event at Etno Selo Kokorici.
