



The second one is subtitled.


New Publication

Dr Criena Fitzgerald's new book *For a Better Life* – *Yugoslavs on the Goldfields of Western Australia 1890-1970* was published last year. There are few copies in New Zealand. One will be in our Archive and Museum.

Criena Fitzgerald is an Honorary Research Fellow in History at the University of Western Australia and author of several history books. This book covers the social, economic and political aspects of the lives of Dalmatian immigrants to Western Australia particularly their experience in the gold mining industry and the allied wood cutting industry. It is meticulously researched, with many interviews and personal stories. The author has told the stories of everyday

interviews and personal stories. The author has told the stories of everyday people in a way that is enjoyable and gripping. The book is also lovely to look at, a beautiful publication.

Should several members want to buy a copy we would be able to order a box of books from the author. They would cost around \$95 each (including shipping) depending on the exchange rate.

Mask Use:

A face covering now needs to be an actual mask and attached to the head by loops around the ears or head.

Scarves, bandannas, or t-shirts can no longer be used.
