#### **UPDATE FROM THE SOCIETY'S COVID RESPONSE TEAM**

As you will all be aware, the Government has reviewed and made changes to the Covid 19 Protection Framework.

For the Dalmatian Cultural Society, we have now reviewed the processes we had in place and have made the following changes **effective from Tuesday 5 April 2022** regardless of what traffic light colour Auckland or New Zealand move to. This is in accordance with the latest government regulations:

We will no longer require the use of My Vaccine Pass for entry requirements. This also applies to any roles within the Society and Nelson Buildings.

There is no requirement to scan in on entry, but the QR code poster will remain at the entrance if people choose to scan for their own records.

We will follow the requirements under the Governments simplified Traffic light setting for capacity limits, mask use and any other guidance within the colours.

The Activities under each colour has also been updated and is included above.

Please note, as always, we will continue to review Government advice and when changes occur will assess what this may mean for the operation of the Dalmatian Cultural Society and Nelson Buildings.

Clearly write the name of the person you wish to nominate and circle the position he/she wishes to fill and have him/her sign the form. You, the nominator must clearly write your name, sign the nomination form at the bottom of the page and state your address and the date when it was signed.
