Our first meeting for the New Year will be held on Sunday 5th March 2023 Speaker: Tania Matulović-Mahoney One Culture - Two Worlds

My parents are both of Dalmatian heritage, yet they are very different. Dad was born in Žrnovo and grew up during World War 2. Mum was born in New Zealand in a predominantly Dalmatian community where she knew almost everyone's names from the Panorama Road, Mt Wellington.

My talk will include stories of my family and their ancestors in these different environments. My ancestors are mostly from Korcula but also some from Hvar, and the mainland. My grandparents were born in Žrnovo, Smokvica, and Račišće. I will also discuss the process I have used to gather information on my family history from various sources such as help from other family members, searching various original records, and genealogical databases and putting it all together.

Giant olive tree story further information

The popular J5 variety of olive is a clone of one of the two giant trees growing on the southern side of the Whangape harbour. It was grown from cuttings taken by Milton Johnson a nurseryman who ran a plant nursery near Kaikohe in the 1960s. The 'J' stands for Johnson and number '5' must have been the best clone.

A little more information has been discovered. This was the wedding of Matilda Gabelich from Vrboska (daughter of Visko and Matija), to Toma (Thomas) Blaskovich from Vrboska (son of Ante and Marija). It took place at All Souls Church Devonport on Wednesday 23 January 1924. Sadly, apart from the bride and groom and Mr Scansie, the members of the group remain unidentified.

Mystery Photo, large Tamburica Orchestra

This remarkable photo has appeared on our DA&M Facebook group and we have learned that it was taken in Zrnovo (Korčula) in front of the church of St. Martin. The label in the centre of the image indicates that the group are the Postrana Tamburaško Društvo Žrnovo, and that it was taken in 1921. The original print was copied by Savoy Studios, Auckland. We have identified only one of the faces. We ask our members of Žrnovo background to please look at your old family photos to see if you can help.
