The joint presentation of the project with lectures and workshops on Croatian science, language and culture will take place at the end of February 2023 in New Zealand. Presentations and lectures on Croatian cultural, literary and scientific heritage will be held by the project manager prof. Luka Budak (Macquarie University, Sydney) and colleagues, Marijana Borić Ph. D. (HAZU) and Josip Lasić Ph. D. (University of Zadar).

In addition to lectures and workshops, the virtual exhibition "The World Reach of Croatian Science" will be presented (Exhibition organizer: Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts; exhibition partner: National and University Library in Zagreb) and an educational workshop for children and young people "Faust Vrančić – Croatian Leonardo da Vinci".

After they have visited Whangarei, Kaitaia and Dargaville the week before they will be presenting the virtual exhibition at the club on

FILM: A Very Nice Honeymoon

Made by the great grandsons of Mariano and Elizabetta Vella about a dramatic part of their great grand-parents life story.

Mariano first arrived in Wellington, New Zealand in 1878. By Christmas of 1889 he was widower with three small children and a farm on Mana Island. In 1894 he made a trip home and met and married Elizabetta Tarabochia on the Island of Lošinj. They immediately set off for New Zealand, crossing the Tasman sea on the SS Wairarapa which wrecked in fog on Great Barrier Island on 29th October 1894.

This is a beautifully crafted animation using real voice recordings of their great grandmother and other relatives. It brings the experiences of Mariano and Elizabetta to life. You must see this.

From the 1930s to the late 1960s freelance photographers plied their trade on the main streets of big cities, taking 'portrait' photos of people walking along the footpath.
