Hazel Petrie (historian and author)

2pm Sunday 5 May 2024 in the Member's Lounge

Hazel will first talk about the methods she used to do the genealogical research that led her to Stari Grad's (Hvar) 15th century records.

Then, she will tell us about her husband's grandfather, Ante Petrić, later known as Tony Anthony Petrie, led a very interesting life. Ante fled Hvar in a big hurry. He soon found himself in a prison in New Zealand but went on to be involved in several industries, as well as negotiations with the New Zealand Government concerning Dalmatian service in World War One.

He was closely involved in the 1919 Sokol club and the subsequent Jugoslav Club from 1930, as were other members of the Petrie family. This talk will be of great interest to genealogy researchers and to those who enjoy learning about the many facets of our history in New Zealand.

A candidate for the office of President, Vice Presidents (2 positions), Secretary or Treasurer must have been a financial member for at least five consecutive years preceding the date nominations close.

Any person wishing to stand for the executive (15 positions) is required to have been a financial member for at least three consecutive years preceding the date nominations close.

Members who are members of any organisation which specifically represents people of any ethnic group or nations represented by the Society are precluded from standing for any position in the Society.

The Management Committee has asked that <u>all Candidates</u> wishing to avail themselves for any position on the Management Committee 2023-2024 prepare a short paragraph (2-4 Sentences) which includes your reasons for standing for the Management Committee and also what involvement you have had in the Society. This is so that the members who will be voting at the AGM are better prepared for choosing the right candidates for these positions. This will be published in the next newsletter along with the named candidates. This also includes the present Management Committee Members who will be offering themselves again. We have many new members and they do want to be as well informed as possible when they are making choices.
