## Auckland War Memorial Museum Recipes Project

Nina Finigan, curator at the Auckland Museum, is developing an archive of recipes and food stories connected to migrants living in New Zealand. Nina is looking for people to talk about their family recipes.



This project is about an essential part of human existence, a part which historically involved largely women's work. Themes of migration and settlement, community and belonging, cultural disruption and preservation, all have a bearing on who we are and what we eat. To talk about food is to talk about life.
