Auckland Rescue Helicopter Trust Fundraiser


We raised \$6,000





Swimming Career:

Beijing 2008 Paralympics: Won a gold medal in swimming.

London 2012 Paralympics: Secured another gold medal.

Rio 2016 Paralympics: Achieved a gold medal and set a world record in the 150m medley event.

Wheelchair Rugby:

Cameron Leslie is also a member of the "Wheel Blacks," New Zealand's national wheelchair rugby team, showcasing his versatility as an athlete.

Recognition and Awards:

Received his 'numbered' Paralympic pin as part of The Celebration Project in Whangarei in May 2019.

Nominated for a prestigious Laureus Award in 2023, highlighting his global recognition as one of the top Para athletes.

Won the Halberg Award in 2024, a significant honor in New Zealand sports.

Personal Background:


Cameron Leslie was born in Whangarei, New Zealand. His grandfather was a Srhoj, which hints at his diverse family heritage.
