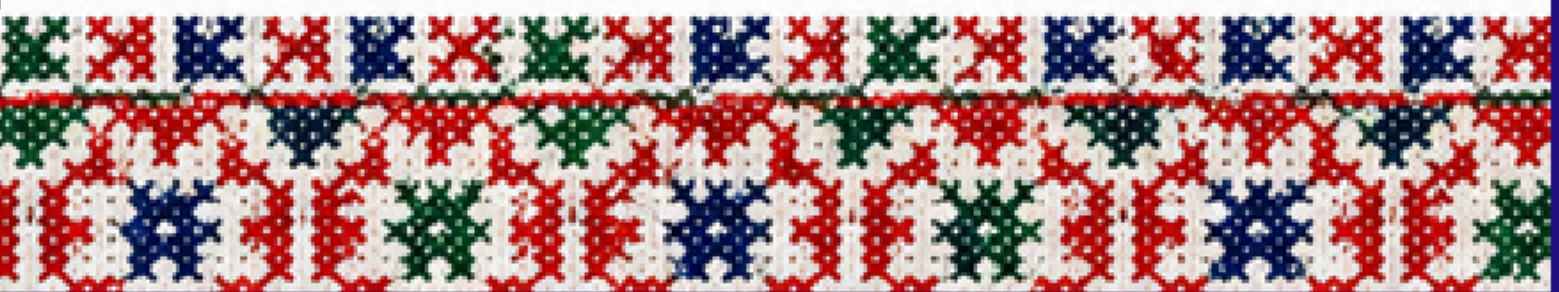

Josephine Wells (nee Antunovich) was born in Auckland on 30 June 1926, less than a year after her parents, Stipe and Marija, emigrated from Živogošće, Croatia. They established a fish shop in Ponsonby before moving to Oratia, where they built a home, planted vineyards, and created Golden Gate Vineyards.

Growing up during World War II, Josephine learned the value of hard work and resilience.

A proud member of Auckland's Dalmatian community, she enjoyed kolo dancing, social gatherings, and lifelong friendships. At 50 she discovered indoor bowls, becoming a passionate player, administrator, and leader, serving as President of both Auckland and Western Indoor Bowls.

Josephine also developed a love of travel, especially Norfolk Island, where she formed many lasting friendships. Now celebrating her 100th year, she continues to enjoy weekly coffee catch-ups and the company of family and friends. Her warmth, humour, generosity, and remarkable spirit have made her life an inspiration to all who know her.

Postal Ballot **(Rule 9.10 DKD Constitution)**

A member may cast their vote at the Annual General Meeting on Sunday 2 August 2026 for elections to the Management Committee by Postal Ballot.

When requesting a Postal Ballot, the member needs to state his/her current home address, telephone number and current membership. A member cannot make a request for a Postal Ballot on behalf of another person, nor can he/she pick up Postal Ballot papers on behalf of another member unless the person requesting the postal ballot gives written approval.

Any member seeking ballot papers shall clearly advise the Secretary to where the Ballot papers are to be posted or personally picked up the ballot papers from the Secretary.

When you do your voting, you will need to place your marked Ballot Papers into a tamperproof plastic envelope which will be provided to you by the Secretary. On the front you will need to write: SCRUTINEERS and on the back, you will need to write your FULL NAME, MEMBERSHIP NUMBER and your SIGNATURE.

You then seal this envelope and place it in another envelope, which is addressed to:

You can also personally deliver your postal ballot to the Secretary.

Postal Ballot papers need to be in the hands of the Secretary no later than 2pm, Saturday 1 August 2026.

Your unopened postal ballots will be handed to the Scrutineers, who will place them into the ballot box in the Ballroom on the day of the Annual General Meeting, Sunday 2 August 2026.

Welcome to our new tutors

We're delighted to introduce two new faces leading our music and dance programmes this year.

We are thrilled to welcome **Roland Sokcevic** as tutor and leader of our **Tamburica Orchestra**.

Roland received his music education from an early age in Croatia, graduating from a secondary music school with a major in music theory. He spent ten years playing mandolin, guitar, bisernica, and contrabass (double bass) with several Dalmatian klapas, most notably Punta Skala and Donat in Zadar. As a member of Punta Skala, he recorded three SP vinyl records during the 1980s and served as the group's tutor for five years, until the outbreak of war in the former Yugoslavia.

After settling in New Zealand, he joined the Dalmatian Cultural Society's Tamburica Orchestra in the late 1990s, performing under the tutorship of Paul Marinovich until around 2007, when he and his family moved overseas for an extended period.

Our **Junior and Intermediate kolo** groups are now tutored by **Mariann Batinica**, one of our "kolo mums", who stepped up to teach this year, and we are so glad she did. Mariann's son Dominik dances in the Junior group, so this is very much a family affair. Mariann is Canadian, originally from Hamilton, Ontario, and came to the club on arrival to make new friends, joining our Senior Kolo group (now TFE). She met Nikola Batinica here, and the rest is history. Please join us in welcoming Mariann too!
